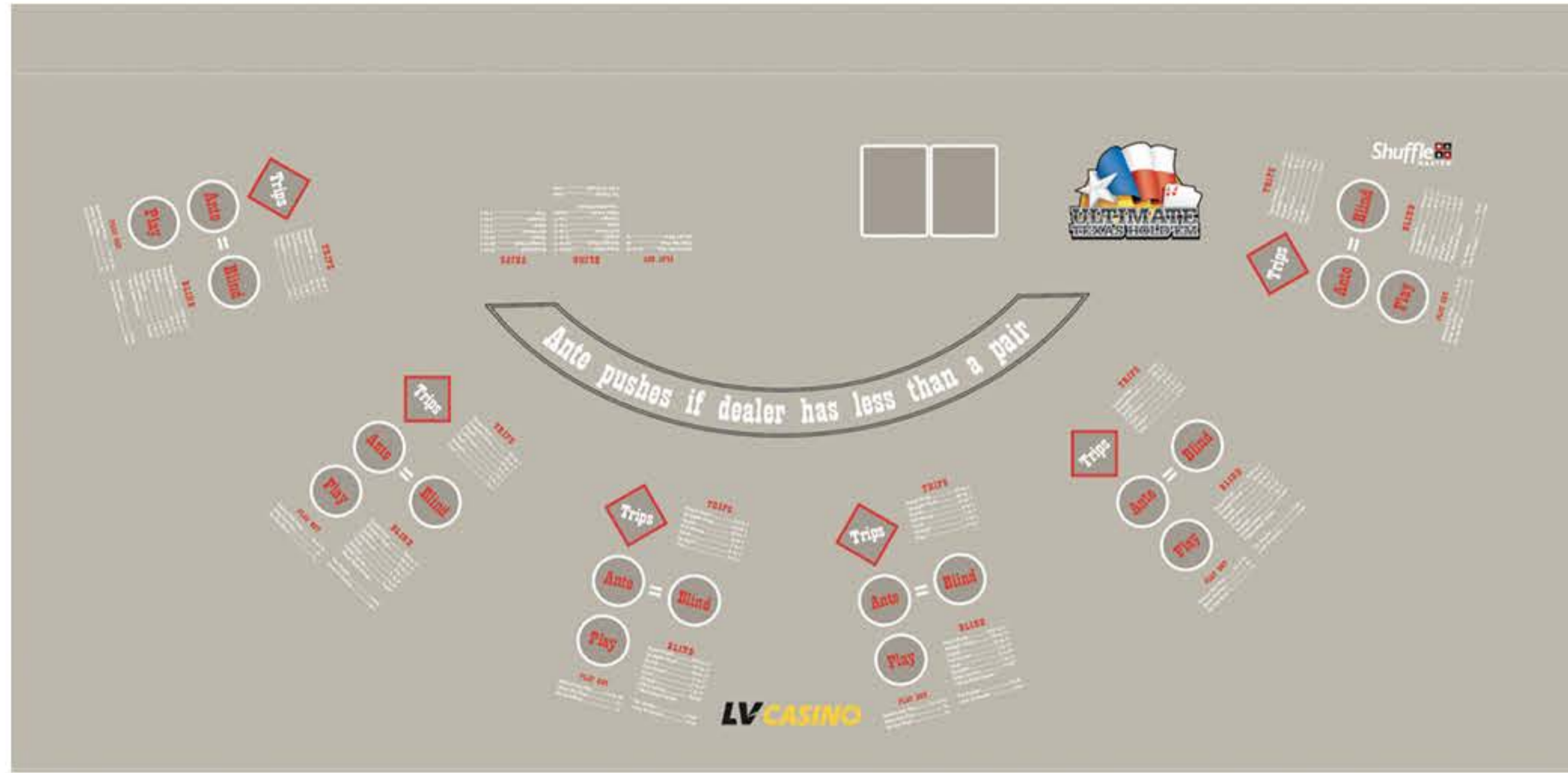




# Ultimate Texas Hold'em



## Aim of the game

You're a fan of Texas Hold'em? Then this exciting casino variation is just the thing for you!

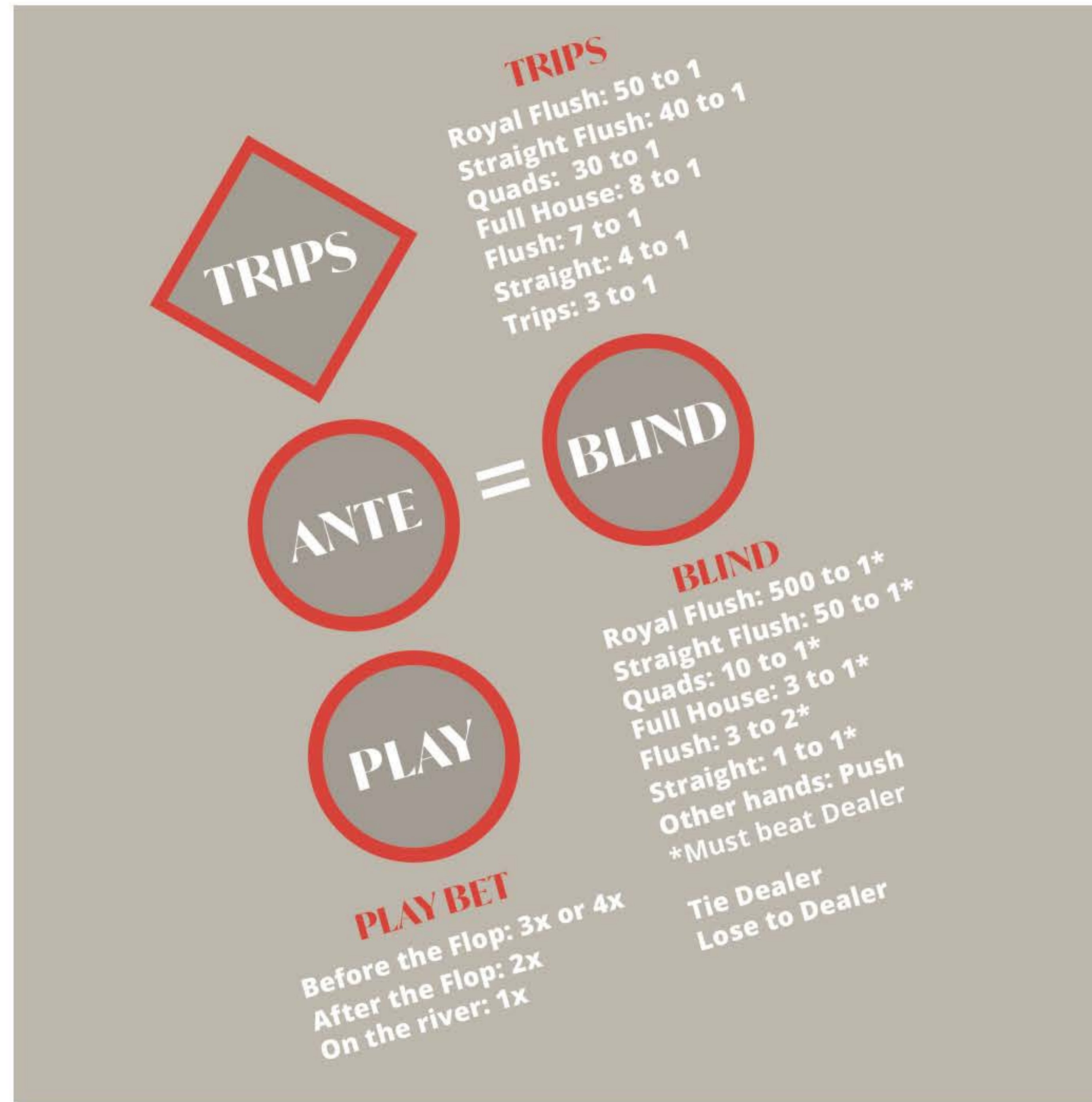
Just like in Texas Hold'em, all players are first dealt two cards face down. The same applies to the bank. This is followed by several rounds of betting during which the community cards ("the board") are revealed. You form your five-card hand from these seven cards. Only the five most advantageous for you are taken into account.

With Ultimate Texas Hold'em, you only have to win against the bank! The other players' cards are of no importance.

## Game play

To participate in the game, place equal bets on the areas Ante and Blind. That is your initial stake. You can also optionally bet on the bonus game Trips. Two cards are then dealt to all players and the bank. The choice is now yours: if you think your cards are particularly good, you can place a bet on the area Play. Caution: you can only place one bet here and it is not possible to increase your bet later.

You prefer to wait? By tapping on the table or announcing "check", you can skip a round and view the first cards of the board without any further bet.



### Flop:

The board consists of five community cards, which are revealed in two rounds of betting. Once all players have examined their cards and placed any bets, the dealer reveals the first three cards on the board, the so-called Flop. If you have not yet bet on Play, you can now wager double your initial Ante stake. If your hand has not improved, you can also call "Check".

### Turn and River:

Once the players have completed the wagering round, the dealer reveals the last two cards on the board: Turn and River. If you have not yet made a Play bet, you can do so now, wagering same amount as your initial stake. If you think that your hand will still not be better than the dealer's, you can fold. In this case, all the bets you have made are lost.

### Trips:

In addition to your initial bet on Ante and Blind, you can also bet on the bonus game Trips. The value of your wager is independent of your initial stake. Your bet will be paid out if you have at least Three of a Kind – regardless of whether or not you win against the dealer.

Possible winning card combinations:

**Royal Flush:**

A Royal Flush is the best possible hand in the game and consists of an Ace, King, Queen, Jack and ten of the same suit.

**Straight Flush:**

A Straight Flush consists of five consecutive cards of the same suit.

**Four of a Kind:**

Four cards of the same value. The highest Four of a Kind wins.

**Full House:**

A Full House is the combination of Three of a Kind and a Pair. The player with the highest Three of a Kind wins. If two players have the same Three of a Kind, the player with the best pair wins.

**Flush:**

Any five cards of the same suit. The player with the highest card in the Flush wins. If two players have the same highest card, the next highest card counts.

**Straight:**

Five consecutive cards, not all of the same suit. The highest straight consists of A-K-Q-J-10, the lowest of A-2-3-4-5.

**Three of a Kind:**

Three cards of the same rank. If two players have the same Three of a Kind, the highest fourth or fifth card counts.

**Two Pairs:** 

Two pairs of cards. The player with the highest pair wins. If two players have the same two pairs then the highest fifth card wins.

**One Pair:** 

Two cards of the same value. The highest pair wins. If two players have the same pair, the highest third card wins.

**Possible winnings**

At the end of the betting rounds, the dealer turns over their cards and reveals their hand. They need at least "One Pair" to qualify. Should this not be case, all Blind bets are returned to the players. They are neither paid nor lost. The dealer then reveals the hand of each consecutive player and compares it with their own hand. If your hand is better than the bank's, the stake on Ante and Play is paid 1:1. Your wager on Blind is paid out provided you have at least a straight. The higher your hand, the higher the payout odds. The same applies for the optional bonus game Trips. Wagers on Blind and Trips are paid out as follows in the case of a win:

Value of hand	Payout ratio Blind	Payout ratio Trips
Royal Flush	500:1	50:1
Straight Flush	50:1	40:1
Four of a Kind	10:1	30:1
Full House	3:1	8:1
Flush	3:2	7:1
Straight	1:1	4:1
Three of a Kind	/	3:1
